I, ALEX THOMAS, declare:

- 1. I am employed as a project manager by Kurtzman Carson Consultants ("KCC"), a nationally-recognized notice and claims administration firm located at 462 South 4th Street, Louisville, KY 40202. KCC was retained as the Settlement Administrator in this case, and as the project manager, I oversee all aspects of the administrative services provided. I submit this declaration regarding the Wolf v Hewlett Packard Company Inc., Notice Program.
- 2. On October 5 2017, in compliance with the Class Action Fairness Act ("CAFA"), 28 U.S.C. Section 1715, KCC mailed via United States Postal Service Priority Mail a cover letter to the U.S. Attorney General and the Attorneys General for Texas and California, along with a CD-ROM containing the following documents: Anne Wolf's Motion for Preliminary Approval, Anne Wolf's Complaints and Supporting Documents, the complaints and supporting documents in the *Anthony Fehrenbach v. H.P. Inc, Carlos Romero*

- v. HP Inc, and Robin Sergi v. HP, Inc. actions. Copies of the cover letter and the mailing list for the CAFA notice are attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- 3. Between November 17, 2017 and April 9, 2018, Class counsel in cooperation with retailers Ebay, Office Max/Office Depot, Wal-Mart, and Fry's Electronics provided KCC approximately 50 files containing names and mailing addresses of Settlement Class Members. KCC reviewed and the data and processed the names and addresses through the United States Postal Service ("USPS") National Change of Address database. KCC identified and removed 1,772 records with no valid physical address and 62,505 duplicate records. There remained a total of 35,963 records with a postal address that could be sent notice.
- 4. On April 23, 2018, KCC established a website for this settlement at www.wolfsmartinstallclassaction.com. On the website, visitors can view answers to frequently asked questions, download important case documents including the settlement agreement, preliminary approval order, notice, claim form, exclusion form, notice in Spanish, and Order Setting Objection Deadline. Visitors could also submit claims online.
- 5. On April 23, 2018, KCC established a toll free telephone number that Class Members could call and listen to answers to Frequently Asked Questions, hear important dates and deadlines, or request a Claim Form be sent to them.
- 6. On April 23, 2018, KCC commenced mailing Double Postcard Claim Forms to 35,963 Class Members whose physical address was available. A true and correct copy of the Double Postcard Claim Form is attached as Exhibit B, respectively.
- 7. KCC caused Indirect Notice in the form of Newspaper publications and Internet ads to be run from April 27, 2018 through June 26, 2018. Tear sheets and screen shots of the ads are attached as Exhibit C.

- 8. To date, KCC has received a total of 236 Notice Packages returned by the U.S. Postal Service with forwarding addresses. KCC caused the Class Member list to be updated with the new addresses and Notice Packages to be re-mailed to the updated addresses.
- 9. Prior to the claim filing deadline, KCC received a total of 2,998 Notice Packages returned by the U.S. Postal Service. KCC ran a search for an updated address for Class Members whose Notice Packages was returned as undeliverable, and updated and re-mailed the Notice Packages to 1,718 Class Members. KCC was able to deliver Notice successfully to all but 1,280 class members.
- 10. The deadline to submit a request for exclusion ("opt-out") was June 21, 2018. To date, KCC has received 3 timely opt-outs. A list of names of the individuals that have opted out is attached here as Exhibit D.
- 11. The deadline to submit an objection to the settlement was June 21, 2018. The deadline to object to Class Counsels' motion for fees and expenses is October 15th, 2018. To date, KCC has received zero objections.
- 12. The deadline to submit a Claim Form was August 7, 2018. To date, KCC has received 4,904 timely and 8 late Claims. Of those claims, 2,661 claims were submitted online and 2,251 claims were submitted via postal mail. As of the date of this declaration the total number of valid printers claimed is 8,203. Claims are still undergoing review for duplicates and eligibility.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that this declaration was executed this September 4th, 2018, at Louisville, Kentucky.

The court did not decide in favor of Plaintiff or HP. HP denies any violation. However, to settle the ease, HP will agree to pay \$20.00 per qualifying printer, to each person who submits a valid claim.

HP's and third party retailers' records indicate that you might be included in the Settlement as a Settlement Class Member because you may have purchased a qualifying printer during the class period.

People receiving this Notice may be entitled to make a claim for a benefit from this Settlement. To receive a benefit, you must complete and mail the attached Claim Form by July 21, 2018. One of the regular fundraising activities of the American Contract Bridge League is to produce simultaneous pairs events with a commentary. This allows people to compare their results at the table with what, in theory, is par on the board.

In today's deal from a recent such event, South does not possess a classic opener. (Indeed, Ely Culbertson might be turning in his grave at the idea of opening a hand with no aces and a bare, balanced 12-count.) Having said that, with nobody vulnerable at pairs, it often pays to get in early and try to steal the contract. You'd expect West to bid spades over one diamond, and now North-South rate to reach three no-trump, probably by South, and most likely on a spade lead. (Of course, if West leads hearts, declarer will come home with no problem)

Since declarer does not have second sight, he will probably win the spade ace, cash the club ace, then play a club to the eight and take the club king. To keep himself in the game, West must pitch two diamonds and a spade; if he pitches a heart, declarer establishes a third heart trick without too much trouble.

But after this start, South will have a shrewd idea of West's original distribution: To bring home his contract, South must lead a heart to the nine at trick five. As the commentary indicates, any declarer who reads the cards this well will truly deserve

THE ACES ON BRIDGE®

"Does the end justify the means? That is possible. But what will justify the end? To that question, which historical thought leaves pending, rebellion replies: the means."

When I saw this deal reported from Honors Bridge Club in New York, it was written up with the heading of "The Curse of Scotland?" It came up in December 2017, and it was a hand where East-West were robbed of a chance for brilliancy - all be-

cause of the diamond nine. Judy Weisman sat West, and she started the defense on the right lines when she led the club king, an inspired shot against the slam, because it forced declarer to take his discards at once. (If declarer had had a singleton spade, he would have been forced

to cut his own communications.) Declarer won the club ace and played two top spades, pitching a club on the first. Put yourself in East's shoes and plan the defense. Lipkin found the defense that would set the hand no matter which three diamonds his partner had. He ruffed with the ace (an unnatural play in my opinion) to return a diamond; that killed declarer's chances since, whatever he did, he was

left with a heart loser As the cards lay, Lipkin could have ruffed with the diamond 10 but only because his partner had the diamond nine (the Curse of Scotland). For example, switch the nine and eight of trumps, and declarer would overruff the diamond 10 with the jack, then play the heart ace and ruff a heart. He could now lead a spade and maneuver to draw trumps without West being able to promote a trump.

Bid hearts, then raise clubs, which will at least get the basic nature of your hand across to your partner at the cost of a mild overbid.

Zia Mahmood achieved his first reportable coup of the 2001 Cavendish Invitational pairs competition on the very first deal. ("What took him so long?" you might ask.) Zia, as South, opened one heart, and his partner, Billy Eisenberg, jumped to three clubs (systematically, to show a limit raise with four trumps or an unbalanced three-card limit raise). Zia tried a delicate six hearts, and Espen Erichsen, as West, led

a spade to the king and ace. When Zia advanced the club queen, Erichsen won with the club king to play a second spade. At this point, Zia had to find the heart queen. He reasoned that Erichsen's decision to win the club king and return a spade (as opposed to a trump, or instead of letting his partner win the club ace) meant that he must have the

heart queen. Accordingly, Zia, who has never lacked the courage of his convictions, ruffed the spade return and ran the heart jack to make

I was lucky enough to make the slam against world champion opponents after the defense cashed the club ace and tried to cash the spade ace. Now there were enough inferences for me to negotiate the trump suit, though it was by no means a foregone conclusion to get it right.

While I was happy with my result, I will not name the declarer who made a more expensive play. At another table, Ishmael Del'Monte and Neville Eber got to defend against six diamonds doubled, but declarer misguessed hearts, turning a huge potential gain into a huge loss.
