ADMINISTRATOR REGARDING NOTICE**

I, ALEX THOMAS, declare:

1. I am employed as a project manager by Kurtzman Carson Consultants (“KCC”), a nationally-recognized notice and claims administration firm located at 462 South 4th Street, Louisville, KY 40202. KCC was retained as the Settlement Administrator in this case, and as the project manager, I oversee all aspects of the administrative services provided. I submit this declaration regarding the Wolf v Hewlett Packard Company Inc., Notice Program.

2. On October 5 2017, in compliance with the Class Action Fairness Act (“CAFA”), 28 U.S.C. Section 1715, KCC mailed via United States Postal Service Priority Mail a cover letter to the U.S. Attorney General and the Attorneys General for Texas and California, along with a CD-ROM containing the following documents: Anne Wolf’s Motion for Preliminary Approval, Anne Wolf’s Complaints and Supporting Documents, the complaints and supporting documents in the *Anthony Fehrenbach v. H.P. Inc, Carlos Romero*

*v. HP Inc*, and *Robin Sergi v. HP, Inc.* actions. Copies of the cover letter and the mailing list for the CAFA notice are attached hereto as Exhibit A.

3. Between November 17, 2017 and April 9, 2018, Class counsel in cooperation with retailers Ebay, Office Max/Office Depot, Wal-Mart, and Fry's Electronics provided KCC approximately 50 files containing names and mailing addresses of Settlement Class Members. KCC reviewed the data and processed the names and addresses through the United States Postal Service ("USPS") National Change of Address database. KCC identified and removed 1,772 records with no valid physical address and 62,505 duplicate records. There remained a total of 35,963 records with a postal address that could be sent notice.

4. On April 23, 2018, KCC established a website for this settlement at [www.wolfmartinstallclassaction.com](http://www.wolfmartinstallclassaction.com). On the website, visitors can view answers to frequently asked questions, download important case documents including the settlement agreement, preliminary approval order, notice, claim form, exclusion form, notice in Spanish, and Order Setting Objection Deadline. Visitors could also submit claims online.

5. On April 23, 2018, KCC established a toll free telephone number that Class Members could call and listen to answers to Frequently Asked Questions, hear important dates and deadlines, or request a Claim Form be sent to them.

6. On April 23, 2018, KCC commenced mailing Double Postcard Claim Forms to 35,963 Class Members whose physical address was available. A true and correct copy of the Double Postcard Claim Form is attached as Exhibit B, respectively.

7. KCC caused Indirect Notice in the form of Newspaper publications and Internet ads to be run from April 27, 2018 through June 26, 2018. Tear sheets and screen shots of the ads are attached as Exhibit C.

8. To date, KCC has received a total of 236 Notice Packages returned by the U.S. Postal Service with forwarding addresses. KCC caused the Class Member list to be updated with the new addresses and Notice Packages to be re-mailed to the updated addresses.

9. Prior to the claim filing deadline, KCC received a total of 2,998 Notice Packages returned by the U.S. Postal Service. KCC ran a search for an updated address for Class Members whose Notice Packages was returned as undeliverable, and updated and re-mailed the Notice Packages to 1,718 Class Members. KCC was able to deliver Notice successfully to all but 1,280 class members.

10. The deadline to submit a request for exclusion (“opt-out”) was June 21, 2018. To date, KCC has received 3 timely opt-outs. A list of names of the individuals that have opted out is attached here as Exhibit D.

11. The deadline to submit an objection to the settlement was June 21, 2018. The deadline to object to Class Counsels’ motion for fees and expenses is October 15<sup>th</sup>, 2018. To date, KCC has received zero objections.

12. The deadline to submit a Claim Form was August 7, 2018. To date, KCC has received 4,904 timely and 8 late Claims. Of those claims, 2,661 claims were submitted online and 2,251 claims were submitted via postal mail. As of the date of this declaration the total number of valid printers claimed is 8,203. Claims are still undergoing review for duplicates and eligibility.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the United States of America that the foregoing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and that this declaration was executed this September 4th, 2018, at Louisville, Kentucky.

On behalf of HP Inc. ("Defendant"), I write pursuant to the Class Action Fairness Act (28 U.S.C. Section 1715) to provide notice of the filing of a proposed class action settlement in the following action:

Anne Wolf ("Plaintiff") alleges that Defendant violated California's Consumers Legal Remedies Act, Cal. Civ. Code § 1750, *et seq.* ("CLRA") by falsely advertising a printer that she purchased.

Three other actions were filed on behalf of other plaintiffs based on similar allegations: (1) *Anthony Fehrenbach v. H.P. Inc.*, No. 3:16-cv-02297-MMA-DDD (S.D. Cal. Sept. 12, 2016); (2) *Carlos Romero v. HP Inc.*, No 5:16-cv-05415-EJD (N.D. Cal. Sept. 21, 2016); and (3) *Robin Sergi v. HP, Inc.*, No 8:16-cv-02225-CJC-DFM (C.D. Cal. Dec. 20, 2016). The *Fehrenbach* and *Sergi* actions asserted claims under the CLRA, California's Unfair Competition Law, Cal. Bus. & Prof. Code §§ 17200, *et seq.* and California's False Advertising Law Cal., Bus. & Prof. Code §§ 17500 *et seq.* The *Romero* action asserted claims under the Texas Deceptive Trade Practices

Act, Texas Business and Commerce Code, § 17.50, *et seq.* The settlement reached in this action will dispose of these other plaintiff's claims.

Defendant has denied any liability, and the merits of Plaintiff's claims. Defendant agreed to settle these cases because litigation can be uncertain and the potential penalties constituted an unreasonable risk to Defendant and its customers.

In accordance with 28 U.S.C. Section 1715(b)(1)–(b)(8), Defendant states the following about the proposed settlement of this action:

1. The enclosed CD contains copies of Plaintiff's Complaint, First Amended Complaint, and Second Amended Complaint, including all materials filed with them. The CD also includes copies of all complaints filed in the *Fehrenbach*, *Sergi*, and *Romero* actions, and any materials filed with them.

2. At this time, there is a preliminary approval hearing set in this case on October 23, 2017 at 1:30 p.m., in Courtroom 7C, 350 West 1st Street, Los Angeles, CA 90012.

3. The enclosed CD contains a copy of the proposed notification to class members of the proposed settlement and their right to request exclusion from it (attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Counsel filed in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement).

4. The enclosed CD contains a copy of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement and Incorporated Memorandum of Law, filed on September 25, 2017, and all supporting papers filed therewith, including the proposed class action settlement (attached as Exhibit 1 to the Declaration of Counsel filed in support of the Motion).

5. The parties' entire agreement is set forth in the enclosed proposed class action settlement. There are no other contemporaneously made agreements.

6. The Court has not issued a final judgment and Plaintiffs have not filed a notice of dismissal.

7. It is not currently feasible to provide the names of class members who reside in each State and their estimated proportionate share of the entire settlement. Accordingly, the enclosed CD contains reasonable estimates generated from official data from the United States Census Bureau.

8. To date, there have been no written judicial opinions relating to the materials described in paragraphs (3) through (6), above.

You further agree to furnish additional information to support your claim if required to do so.

A Settlement has been reached with HP Inc., formerly known as Hewlett-Packard Company ("HP") in a class action lawsuit claiming it manufactured, marketed, advertised and sold printers that were advertised to have "HP Smart Install," a feature designed to allow for the easy software installation of the printers, when in fact this feature has been disabled from these printers, between April 2014, and present ("class period"). The court did not decide in favor of Plaintiff or HP. HP denies any violation. However, to settle the case, HP will agree to pay \$20.00 per qualifying printer, to each person who submits a valid claim.

HP's and third party retailers' records indicate that you might be included in the Settlement as a Settlement Class Member because you may have purchased a qualifying printer during the class period.

People receiving this Notice may be entitled to make a claim for a benefit from this Settlement. To receive a benefit, you must complete and mail the attached Claim Form by July 21, 2018. Claims may also be submitted online at [www.wolfmartinstallclassaction.com](http://www.wolfmartinstallclassaction.com) or downloaded from the website, printed and mailed to the Claims Administrator; or by calling 1-866-654-2869. If the Court approves the Settlement, people who submit a valid Claim Form will be paid \$20.00 per qualifying printer they certify they purchased. This amount will not be impacted by any attorney's fees or costs associated with this settlement, as such amounts will be paid separately and subject to the discretion of the Court.

If you don't want to be legally bound by the Settlement or receive a payment from it, you must exclude yourself from it within 90 days following entry by the court of the Preliminary Approval Order, or by June 21, 2018. Unless you exclude yourself, you will be bound by the terms of this Settlement Agreement, including but not limited to, its release. If you stay in the Settlement (i.e., don't exclude yourself), you may object to it or you may ask for permission for you or your own lawyer to appear and speak at the hearing—at your own cost—but you do not have to. 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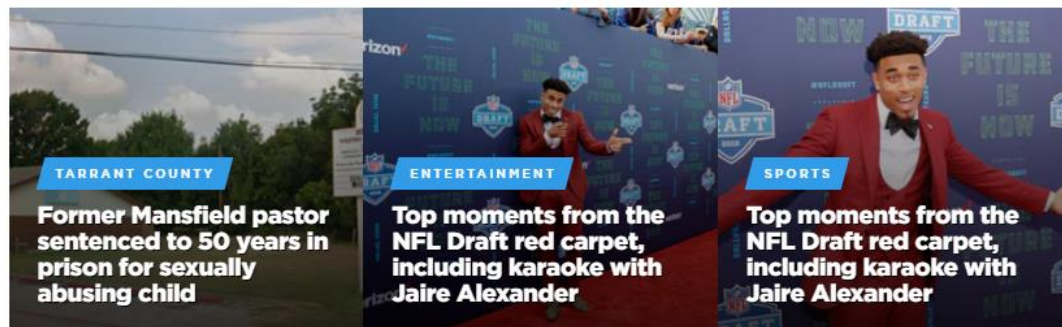

When I saw this deal reported from Honors Bridge Club in New York, it was written up with the heading of "The Curse of Scotland?" It came up in December 2017, and it was a hand where East-West were robbed of a chance for brilliancy — all because of the diamond nine.

Judy Weisman sat West, and she started the defense on the right lines when she led the club king, an inspired shot against the slam, because it forced declarer to take his discards at once. (If declarer had had a singleton spade, he would have been forced to cut his own communications.)

Declarer won the club ace and played two top spades, pitching a club on the first. Put yourself in East's shoes and plan the defense. Lipkin found the defense that would set the hand no matter which three diamonds his partner had. He ruffed with the ace (an unnatural play in my opinion) to return a diamond; that killed declarer's chances since, whatever he did, he was left with a heart loser.

As the cards lay, Lipkin could have ruffed with the diamond 10 — but only because his partner had the diamond nine (the Curse of Scotland). For example, switch the nine and eight of trumps, and declarer would overruff the diamond 10 with the jack, then play the heart ace and ruff a heart. He could now lead a spade and maneuver to draw trumps without West being able to promote a trump.

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Bobby Wolff

**Zia Mahmood** achieved his first reportable coup of the 2001 Cavendish Invitational pairs competition on the very first deal. ("What took him so long?" you might ask.) Zia, as South, opened one heart, and his partner, Billy Eisenberg, jumped to three clubs (systematically, to show a limit raise with four trumps or an unbalanced three-card limit raise). Zia tried a delicate six hearts, and Espen Erichsen, as West, led a spade to the king and ace.

When Zia advanced the club queen, Erichsen won with the club king to play a second spade. At this point, Zia had to find the heart queen. He reasoned that Erichsen's decision to win the club king and return a spade (as opposed to a trump, or instead of letting his partner win the club ace) meant that he must have the heart queen.

Accordingly, Zia, who has never lacked the courage of his convictions, ruffed the spade return and ran the heart jack to make his slam.

I was lucky enough to make the slam against world champion opponents after the defense cashed the club ace and tried to cash the spade ace. Now there were enough inferences for me to negotiate the trump suit, though it was by no means a foregone conclusion to get it right.

While I was happy with my result, I will not name the declarer who made a more expensive play. At another table, Ishmael Del'Monte and Neville Eber got to defend against six diamonds doubled, but declarer misguessed hearts, turning a huge potential gain into a huge loss.

ANSWER: East's double of one club should not significantly influence your choice here. With a six-loser hand, you certainly have enough to try for game. The question is whether you should jump to four spades or make a game try of three diamonds. I could go either way on this hand.
